


M5-M50 NGM - Newsletter Christmas 2021

Prototype inspiration from Rowland Binns:

Rowland sent these photos from the Ffestiniog Railway's Supporters Day held on the 10th October 2021.











From left to right and top to bottom:

The first photo shows Linda's boiler ready for its hydraulic test but in front of it is the upturned chassis, wheels and cylinders of the Bagnall 'Pixie' — the one once belonging to Teddy Boston. It looks to me so like a model under construction. The second photo shows a boiler on a wagon in the yard at Boston Lodge which is off the Single Fairlie 'Taliesin'. The third photo is of the other bits of 'Linda' and 'Taliesin' in the old loco shed. The fourth photo is 'Lyd' drawing the train into Boston Lodge halt to pick us up to officially open new south portal of Moelwyn tunnel.

Hornby Caledonian Pug 0-4-0 mechanism – Michael Beer:

As covered in previous newsletters, I wanted to do a 7mm scale double Fairlie but two mechanisms could be rather expensive. So I decided to use two Hornby Caledonian pugs and put up with the "pocket rocket" speed so widely condemned on internet forums. I was delighted to find they run smoothly and at sensible speed. I checked with Hornby Customer service who confirmed that the mechanism had been changed (2018) and I can count on similar performance from now on.

I then asked if anybody had suggested an upmarket 0-4-0 chassis with proper spindles, crossheads etc. The guy said "no - but I will pass it on."

I only asked 'cos I was so impressed by Simon Kohler and his young team on the telly.
